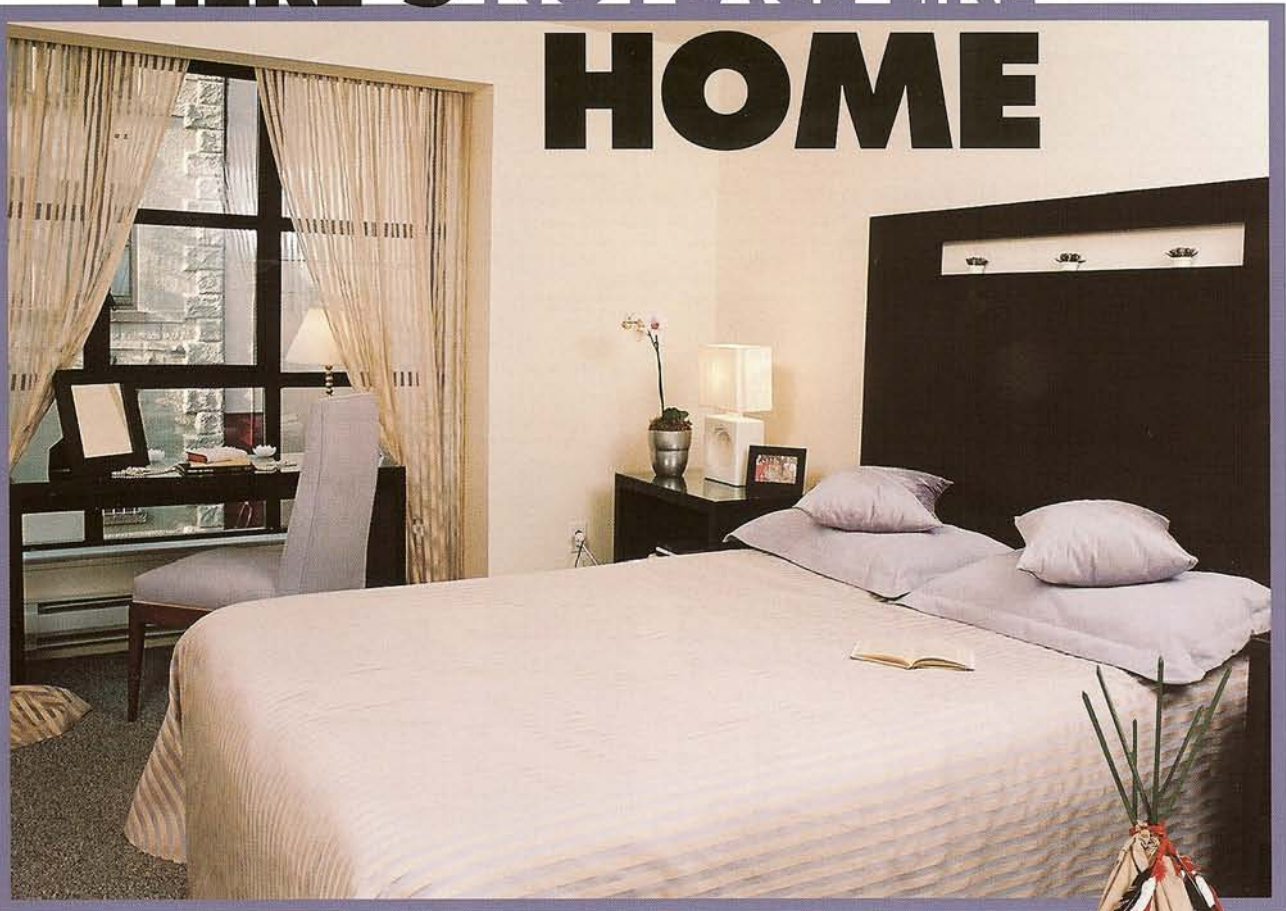

### FURNITURE & DESIGN INDUSTRIES HELP GIVE HOMELESS FAMILIES A PLACE TO CALL HOME

**H**omeless families in San Francisco now have a place to call home, as well as furniture upon which to sit, sleep and eat, thanks to Episcopal Community Services and Philanthropy by Design.

The Homeless Families Initiative, Project 180°, led by Episcopal Community Services, built 48 units of new residential housing for homeless families. Philanthropy By Design furnished and decorated the units with the help of the San Francisco Mart and its tenants, ASID Northern California Chapter and the San Francisco Quilter's Guild.

This project helps very low-income families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. The new family housing not only offers shelter but also an array of programs, such as job training, counseling, health care, day care and after school programs for children and teens. *sfm*
